AN ACT Relating to Conveyance of Public Secondary School Pupils.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 41, § 14, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 14 of chapter 41 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

‘The superintendent of schools in each town shall procure the conveyance of all **public elementary and secondary** school pupils residing in his town, a part or the whole of the distance, to and from the nearest suitable school, for the number of weeks for which schools are maintained in each year, when such pupils reside at such a distance from the said school as in the judgment of the superintending school committee shall render such conveyance necessary.’
