STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Plymouth.

Town of Plymouth; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of the town of Plymouth the sum of \$10,500 from the general highway fund to complete state aid road No. 3 in said town.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

There is .75 miles of unimproved road left on that designation. It will need about \$200 worth of culverts. Due to the swampy land over a great part of the distance it will take a good base to bring it up to proper grade and strength. All materials are a mile from the location of this job. The estimated cost by the State Highway Commission is \$10,500.
