**AN ACT Relating to Closed Time on Deer in Certain Counties.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 37, § 91, amended.** The 1st and 2nd paragraphs of section 91 of chapter 37 of the revised statutes are hereby repealed and the following paragraphs enacted in place thereof:

‘Except as hereinafter excluded, there shall be an annual open season on deer during the period October 15 to November 30, both dates inclusive, in that portion of the State north of the Appalachian Trail beginning at the western boundary to its junction with the tracks of the Canadian Pacific Railway southeast of Greenville, thence, north of the Canadian Pacific Railway to the eastern border of the State at Vanceboro. Except as provided in section 108 all the rest of the calendar year before and after the open season shall be closed on deer.

Except as hereinafter excluded, there shall be an annual open season on deer during the period November 1 to December 10, both dates inclusive, in that portion of the State south of the above described boundary. Except as provided in section 108, all the rest of the calendar year before and after the open season shall be closed on deer.’
