STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Appeals from Decisions of Liquor Commission.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 61, § 57, amended. The 3rd sentence of the 2nd paragraph of section 57 of chapter 61 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Pending judgment of the court, the decision of the commission in revoking or suspending any license shall remain in full force and effect the person aggrieved shall retain any license issued to him by the Commission.'
