IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, Opening Part of Passagassawaukeag River for Salt Water Smelt Seining.

Passagassawaukeag River open for smelt seining. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Sea and Shore Fisheries be and hereby is authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Passagassawaukeag River, Waldo County, from the head of the tide to 2,000 feet below the Memorial Bridge for the commercial seining of salt water smelts.
