STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Registration Fees for Farm Trucks.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 22, § 19, amended. Section 19 of chapter 22 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding after the 1st paragraph thereof, a new paragraph, to read as follows:

'Provided that the annual fee for registration of farm motor trucks of not less than 9,000 lbs. gross weight and not more than 23,000 lbs. gross weight, when such truck is used only for transportation or agricultural commodities, supplies or equipment to be used in connection with the operation of a farm or farms owned, operated or occupied by the registrant, shall be at a rate equal to $\frac{1}{2}$ the present registration fee provided for trucks by this chapter, except that the minimum fee for farm motor trucks shall be \$20.'

Sec. 2. Effective date. The provisions of this act shall become effective for registration of farm motor trucks for the calendar year 1956.
