STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Payment of Expenses and Increasing Salary of Judge of Lisbon Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1941, c. 51, § 12, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 12 of chapter 51 of the private and special laws of 1941, as last amended by chapter 174 of the private and special laws of 1947, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'The judge of said court shall receive an annual salary of \$1,200 \$1,500 in full for all services, payable quarterly on the 1st days of January, April, July and October, from the treasury of Androscoggin county.'

Sec. 2. P. & S. L., 1941, c. 51, § 13, amended. Section 13 of chapter 51 of the private and special laws of 1941 is hereby amended by adding thereto a new sentence to read as follows:

'The county of Androscoggin shall reimburse the town of Lisbon for expenditures incurred in furnishing blanks, blank books, dockets, stationery and other necessary supplies for said court.'
