STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Definition of Schoolhouses in Laws Relating to Boilers and Unfired Steam Pressure Vessels.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 30, § 78, amended. Section 78 of chapter 30 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new paragraph to read as follows:

'The term "schoolhouse" as used in this section shall include, but shall not be limited to, any structure used by schools or colleges, public or private, for the purpose of housing classrooms, gymnasiums, auditoriums or dormitories.'
