STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Increasing Salaries of Members of Maine Employment Security Commission.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 29, § 4, sub-§ II, amended. Subsection II of section 4 of chapter 29 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'II. Salaries. The Chairman of the Commission shall receive a fixed weekly salary, at the rate of \$7,000 \$8,500 per year, and each of the other members shall receive a fixed weekly salary, at the rate of \$6,500 \$8,000 per year, and shall be paid from the employment security administration fund.'
