RESOLVE, in Favor of Cecil A. York, North Windham, for Damage by Escapees from State School for Boys.

Cecil A. York; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund of the State the sum of \$1080 to be paid to Cecil A. York of North Windham, as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State, for damage done to his 1951 Pontiac Station Wagon by an escapee from the State School for Boys.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

George F. Allen, while on escape from the State School for Boys on the evening of February 9, 1954, stole the 1951 Pontiac Station Wagon of Cecil A. York, of North Windham, was involved in an accident at Yarmouth and abandoned the station wagon. According to information received from police authorities, the car was demolished.
