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**RESOLVE, in Favor of Cecil A. York, North Windham, for Damage by  
Escapes from State School for Boys.**

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**Cecil A. York; reimbursed. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund of the State the sum of \$1080 to be paid to Cecil A. York of North Windham, as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State, for damage done to his 1951 Pontiac Station Wagon by an escapee from the State School for Boys.

**STATEMENT OF FACTS**

George F. Allen, while on escape from the State School for Boys on the evening of **February 9, 1954, stole the 1951 Pontiac Station Wagon of Cecil A. York**, of North Windham, was involved in an accident at Yarmouth and abandoned the station wagon. According to information received from police authorities, the car was demolished.
