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**AN ACT Relating to Qualifications of Applicants for Hairdressing and Beauty Culture.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

**R. S., c. 25, § 220, sub-§ III, amended.** Subsection III of section 220 of chapter 25 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows :

'**III.** Who has satisfactorily completed a course of instruction in a school of hairdressing and beauty culture approved by said Board, or in lieu thereof has had a total experience in the practice of hairdressing and beauty culture or as an apprentice of ~~2,500~~ 1,500 hours distributed over a period of at least ~~18~~ 9 months;'
