STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Qualifications of Applicants for Hairdressing and Beauty Culture.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 25, § 220, sub-§ III, amended. Subsection III of section 220 of chapter 25 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'III. Who has satisfactorily completed a course of instruction in a school of hairdressing and beauty culture approved by said Board, or in lieu thereof has had a total experience in the practice of hairdressing and beauty culture or as an apprentice of 2,500 1,500 hours distributed over a period of at least 18 9 months;'
