STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to the Salary of the Judge of the Sanford Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1915, c. 39, § 1, amended. Section 1 of chapter 39 of the private and special laws of 1915, as last amended by chapter 49 of the private and special laws of 1943, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 1. Salary of judge. The judge of the Sanford municipal court shall receive as compensation an annual salary of ~~\$1,750~~ \$2,500, payable quarterly, on the 1st days of January, April, July and October, from the county treasury of the county of York. He shall account under oath to the treasurer of said county, as provided by law, for all fees received by him, or payable to him by virtue of his office, specifying the items, and shall pay the whole amount of the same to the treasurer of the county of York.'
