STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Broken Bridge Pond, Oxford County.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment; and

Whereas, in order to open Broken Bridge Pond to fishing under the general fishing laws this spring it is vitally necessary that the following legislation be passed; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the constitution of Maine, and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it

Fishing in Broken Bridge Pond, regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game, be and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Broken Bridge Pond, Oxford county, to ice fishing during the months of February and March.

Emergency clause: In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this resolve shall take effect when approved.
