STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Possession of Operator's License When Operating Motor Vehicle.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 60, amended. Section 60 of chapter 22 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof a new paragraph, to read as follows:

'Every licensee shall have his operator's license in his immediate possession at all times when operating a motor vehicle and shall display the same, upon demand of any officer authorized to make arrests in this State.'
