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**AN ACT** Relating to **Prior Convictions in Operating Motor Vehicles Under Influence of Liquor.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 22, § 150, amended.** Section 150 of chapter 22 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof a new paragraph, to read as follows:

**'In allegations charging second or subsequent offenses, the certified copy of the prior convictions from the office of the Secretary of State shall be admitted in evidence as proof of the prior convictions. The copy must state the name, date of birth and address given on the prior convictions.'**
