# STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

#### AN ACT to Amend the Charter of Phillips Electric Light and Power Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1911, c. 208, § 2, amended. Section 2 of chapter 208 of the private and special laws of 1911 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 2. May generate and supply electricity to certain towns. Said corporation is hereby authorized to make, generate, transmit, supply, sell and distribute electricity for light, heat and power, in and throughout the towns of Phillips and, Avon and Madrid, in the county of Franklin, to said towns, corporations, firms and individuals.'
