AN ACT to Amend the Charter of Phillips Electric Light and Power Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1911, c. 208, § 2, amended. Section 2 of chapter 208 of the private and special laws of 1911 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'**Sec. 2. May generate and supply electricity to certain towns.** Said corporation is hereby authorizd to make, generate, transmit, supply, sell and distribute electricity for light, heat and power, in and throughout the towns of Phillips ~~and~~, Avon ~~and~~ Madrid, in the county of Franklin, to said towns, corporations, firms and individuals.'
