RESOLVE, Appropriating Funds to Purchase Land for State House Parking Facilities.

Funds for State House Parking Facilities; appropriated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund the sum of \$37,000 to purchase land of Titcomb Real Estate Association and land of John Coffey on Grove and Capitol Streets in Augusta, to provide parking facilities near the State House; such funds to be expended under the direction of the Governor and Council.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

With the construction of the new State House office building, space for parking facilities is inadequate. The purpose of the resolve is to provide such facilities by the purchase of land near the State House.
