COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 297, L. D. 805, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Preference in State Employment
to Mothers of Veterans."

Amend said bill by striking out the 2nd paragraph and inserting
in place thereof the following:

" 'D. Ten-point preference is accorded to mothers, (who are
widowed, divorced, separated, or whose husbands are permanently and
totally disabled,) of veterans who died while in the active service
of the armed forces during any war, or who died as a result of
service-connected disabilities.' "
