STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, Relating to Use of Seines in Medomak River, Lincoln County.

Use of Seines in Medomak River; prohibited. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Sea and Shore Fisheries, be and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation prohibiting the use of purse, drag, or stop seines in the Medomak River, Lincoln County, above a line drawn from the northerly point of Jones Neck, westerly to Havener Point, being the beginning of the Narrows, so called, in Waldoboro, from the first day of May to the thirtieth day of June, annually.
