RESOLVE, to Reimburse Town of Lincoln for Certain Welfare Case.

Town of Lincoln; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund of the state the sum of \$1,785 to be paid to the town of Lincoln to reimburse them for aid given to Mrs. Donald Davis and children.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mrs. Donald Davis, or Pauline Davis, received assistance, food, supplies, etc. for herself and her 3 children from April 13, 1951 to April 17, 1953. This a non-settled State case. Town of Lincoln wishes reimbursement in the amount of \$1,785.
