STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Designating Federal Aid Secondary Routes as State Highways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 23, § 38, amended. Section 38 of chapter 23 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 38. State highways; expense of construction. The Commission shall be sole arbiter of the designation of state highways, but shall, after reasonable notice by publication, give all parties interested an opportunity to be heard thereon before such designation is made. Notwithstanding the provisions of the preceding sentence, all federal aid secondary routes shall be designated as state highways.

The expense of constructing such state highways shall be borne wholly by the State except as otherwise provided in this chapter.'

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Heavy busses and trucks travel the Estes Head Road, and this road is badly in need of repairs. The old roads have not much travel.
