RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in All River Tributaries at Sebago Lake.

Fishing in All River Tributaries at Sebago Lake; regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game, be and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening all river tributaries to Sebago Lake for fishing under the general law, except Jordon River in Raymond. The Jordon River to be open for fishing from lake upstream to bridge located on Route 302 and closed above bridge located on Route 302 to Panther Pond outlet.
