AN ACT Relating to Approval of Certain Heating Units.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 97, § 46, amended. Section 46 of chapter 97 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by inserting after the 2nd paragraph thereof, a new paragraph, to read as follows:

'No range burner or portable space heater utilizing flammable liquids, flammable liquid compounds with a flash point of 200 degrees Fahrenheit or under, liquefied petroleum gases, artificial, natural or manufactured gases, but excluding floor furnaces and central heating units shall hereafter be sold, offered for sale or installed in this State unless such burner is equipped with a 100% heat activated safety valve having the approved listing of the Department of Industrial Cooperation at the University of Maine. The expense of obtaining such approval shall be borne by the manufacturer, distributors or marketers of such equipment. Each such piece of equipment hereafter offered for sale, sold or installed within this State shall be accompanied by a proper set of instructions for the installation, operation and maintenance thereof.'
