## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

### AN ACT Relating to Age of Apprentice in Practice of Hairdressing and Beauty Culture.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 25, § 223, amended. The next to the last paragraph of section 223 of chapter 25 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Every apprentice, in order to avail himself of the provisions of sections 213 to 230, inclusive, to practice hairdressing and beauty culture shall, within 10 days after entering upon his apprenticeship, file with the secretary of the Board the name and place of business of his employer, the date of commencement of such apprenticeship and the full name and age of said apprentice, which age shall not be less than +7 16 years. Any such apprentice who shall change his place of employment shall promptly notify the Board and furnish it with the name and place of business of his new employer and the date of such change.'
