**AN ACT Relating to Study in Out-of-State Schools of Hairdressing and Beauty Culture.**

---

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 25, § 222, amended.** The 2nd paragraph of section 222 of chapter 25 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by inserting after the 1st sentence thereof, the following sentence:

**'Time spent in any out-of-state school of hairdressing and beauty culture may be credited in full or in part against said 1,500 hours, subject to the decision and approval of the Board.'**
