AN ACT Exempting Towns from the Use Fuel Tax.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 16, § 170, amended. The 5th paragraph of section 170 of chapter 16 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

‘‘Person’’ shall mean and include natural persons and partnerships, firms, associations, corporations, both public and private, ~~and~~ **except** municipalities.’

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 16, § 174, amended. The 1st paragraph of section 174 of chapter 16 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

‘Every user ~~except a municipality~~ shall file with the State Tax Assessor a bond as follows:’
