STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Exempting Agricultural Sprays and Dusts from Sales and Use Tax.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 17, § 10, sub-§ VII, amended. Subsection VII of section 10 of chapter 17 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

‘VII. Seed, feed, fertilizer, agricultural sprays and dusts, and bait. Sales of seed, feed ~~and~~, fertilizer, and agricultural sprays and dusts used in agricultural production and sales of bait to commercial fishermen.’
