STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Exemption of Sales Taxes on Certain Items Pertaining to the Maine Maritime Academy.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 17, § 10, sub-§ IV, amended. Subsection IV of section 10 of chapter 17 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'IV. Ships' stores. Sale of cabin, deck and engine supplies to ships engaged in transporting cargo or passengers for hire in interstate or foreign commerce, not to include fuel and bunkering oil; sales of uniforms, clothing, books, school and training supplies to all officers, midshipmen, cadets and all students enrolled at the Maine Maritime Academy '

Sec. 2. **Effective date.** The provisions of this act shall be retroactive to May 3. 1951.
