STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Simon Oakes of St. John Plantation.

Simon Oakes; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$50 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Simon Oakes, of St. John Plantation, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin on July 1, 1955 and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Simon Oakes is a veteran of World War II, with a disability rated at 22% which does not entitle him to a veteran's pension. He is unable to do any of the heavy-type of work, which is all that is available in his community, and he has been refused assistance by the town officials.
