RESOLVE, to Reimburse the Town of Stetson for Aid Extended to Carlton Johnson.

Town of Stetson; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund of the state the sum of \$144.43 to be paid to the town of Stetson to reimburse them for aid given to Carlton Johnson of Stetson, a state pauper.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Carlton Johnson was furnished groceries in the amounts of \$29.97 and \$89.46, and doctor's services in the amount of \$25; total being \$144.43. Town was not reimbursed by the State because of an oversight in getting the bill in on time, and would like reimbursement of this amount.
