**RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing for Black Bass Through the Ice in Knox
County.**

Fishing for black bass through the ice in Knox County; regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation to permit the taking of black bass through the ice during the months of February and March in all waters open to ice fishing in Knox County.
