STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the University of Maine for a Law School.

University of Maine; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of the University of Maine the sum of \$35,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1956, and the sum of \$35,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1957 for the purpose of establishing and maintaining a law school.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The University of Maine formerly conducted a law school. A law school is needed in Maine so that our boys and girls may receive a legal education within the confines of their own state. The Maine State Bar Association voted to recomment the reestablishing of the Maine Law School.
