IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Establishing the Durham Game Preserve.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 149, amended. Section 149 of chapter 37 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by inserting in alphabetical order thereof, the following:

‘Durham Game Preserve: The following described territory, situated in the town of Durham in the County of Androscoggin beginning at the intersection of Route 136 and the Davis road and extending in a westerly direction along Route 136 approximately 2.7 miles to the point of intersection of the Stackpole road and Route 136; thence southerly and easterly along the Stackpole road approximately 2.6 miles to the Bowie Hill road; thence easterly along the Bowie Hill road approximately 2 miles to the Davis road; thence northerly along the Davis road approximately 1.6 miles to the point of beginning.’
