FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Closed Time on Deer on Frye Island, Cumberland County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 91, amended. Section 91 of chapter 37 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding after the 7th paragraph thereof, a new paragraph, to read as follows:

‘There shall be a continual closed season on deer on the whole of Frye Island in Sebago Lake, Cumberland County.’
