STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Sale of Unused Forest Fire Warden Headquarters Sites.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 36, § 90, amended. Section 90 of chapter 36 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following paragraph:

'The Forest Commissioner, with the approval of the Governor and Council, may sell to the highest bidder after advertising, any warden headquarter site not being used or deemed no longer necessary for such purposes. Sites no longer useful and obtained without cost shall be returned to the previous owners, with no charge.'
