RESOLVE, Authorizing Forest Commissioner to Renew Lease to Passamaquoddy Lumber Company.

Forest Commissioner authorized to renew lease. Resolved: That the Forest Commissioner be, and hereby is, authorized and empowered to renew the lease dated December 6, 1950 whereby the State of Maine did lease unto the Passamaquoddy Lumber Company a piece of land in Indian Township, said renewel to be on the same basis.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

This lease covers a sawmill site of approximately 3.97 acres by Passamaquoddy Lumber Company, for which the State receives \$100 per year. The sawmill is powered by a diesel engine and the lot is confined to the manufacture of lumber.
