AN ACT Permitting the Digging of Clams in Limits of Biddeford for Bait Only.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

Digging of clams in limits of Biddeford for bait. It shall be lawful to dig clams on any of the flats within the territorial limits of the City of Biddeford, York county, provided said clams are not used for any other purpose than as bait for fishing. Such digging and taking shall be limited to residents of the City of Biddeford only and not more than one bushel of clams per person per tide may be taken.
