STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, Relating to a Water System for the Penobscot and Passamaquoddy Indians.

Water System for the Penobscot and Passamaquoddy Indians; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund the sum of \$20,000 to extend the water systems of the Penobscot and Passamaquoddy tribes of Indians.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The present water systems of both Indian tribes are inadequate to supply water for both domestic use and fire prevention. This sum of money will give a more adequate supply by extension and improvement of existing systems.
