STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Open Season on Deer Throughout the State.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 91, amended. The first 2 paragraphs of section 91 of chapter 37 of the revised statutes are hereby repealed and the following paragraph enacted in place thereof:

'There shall be an annual open season on deer from October 21st to November 30th, both days inclusive, in each calendar year in all counties of the State. All the rest of the calendar year before and after the open season shall be a closed season on deer.'
