AN ACT Relating to Educational Requirements for Chiropractors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 72, § 4, amended. The 3rd and 4th sentences of section 4 of chapter 72 of the revised statutes are hereby amended to read as follows:

'Each applicant must be at least 21 years of age and shall present proof of ~~+~~ ~~year's~~ **2 years'** satisfactory attendance at a college of liberal arts. On and after the calendar year ~~1957~~ **1959** candidates for licensure shall be required to present transcripts from an accredited college or university certifying that they have completed ~~+~~ ~~year~~ **2 years** of preprofessional work, 2 subjects of which must be English and biology, or otherwise satisfy the members of the Board of sufficient prior academic education.'
