AN ACT Relating to Trees Within the Highway Limits.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 23, § 32-A, additional. Chapter 23 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 32-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 32-A. Duties relating to trees. Whenever the State Highway Commission shall ascertain that trees within the highway limits, on state and state aid highways are in such condition that they, or parts of them, are in danger of falling on the highway, or are so situated as to be dangerous to users of the highway, and right of way, or as to interfere with necessary vision, it shall cause the trees, or such parts of them as are deemed necessary, to be removed.'
