RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing for Black Bass in Androscoggin County.

Fishing for black bass in Androscoggin County; regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game, be and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation making the black bass open season in Androscoggin County to conform with the general law on black bass, with the exception that fishing for black bass from June 1 through June 20 be restricted to casting, spinning and fly fishing with single-hooked artificial lures.
