# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

## AN ACT Relating to the Reporter of Decisions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. R. S., c. 104, § 2, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 2 of chapter 104 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows: 'He shall publish at least one volume yearly, provided he has material enough to make a volume of the size required by this section, and furnish the usual number of current copies to the State and to the public at a price to be fixed by the Governor and Council.'
- Sec. 2. R. S., c. 104, § 4, repealed. Section 4 of chapter 104 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed, as follows:
- 'See. 4. Advance sheets free to all justices. The reporter shall furnish, free of charge, the justices of the supreme judicial court and superior court with + copy each of advance sheets; he shall also be entitled to 25 copies, free of expense, for current exchanges with the reporters of other states, law school libraries, the attorney general and heads of departments.'
