## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 97th LEGISLATURE

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 840, L. D. 930, Bill, "An Act Relating to Hours of Sale of Liquor."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end thereof the following new section:

"Sec. 3. R. S., c. 61, Sec. 2, sub-Sec. V-A, additional.

Section 2 of chapter 61 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding after subsection V, a new subsection to be numbered V-A, to read as follows:

'V-A. Shall licenses be granted in this city or town for the sale herein of liquor to be consumed on the premises of hotels with meals in their dining rooms on Sundays between the hours of 12:30 P. M. and 8:30 P.M.?'"
