## STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

#### AN ACT Relating to Fishing Licenses for Religious Seminaries.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 37, § 41-A, additional.** Chapter 37 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 41-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 41-A. Licenses for religious seminaries. Upon application, the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game shall issue to a religious seminary a seminary fishing licenses which will permit any of the seminaries to fish in the lake or pond adjacent to which the seminary is located. The fee for this license shall be \$25 for those seminaries of less than 50 seminarians, \$40 for those seminaries with an enrollment of not less than 50 seminarians but not more than 75 seminarians and \$60 for those seminaries with an enrollment of more than 75 seminarians. Those persons who fish under a seminary fishing license as provided in this section shall be subject to all the laws, rules and regulations of this chapter.'
