STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Increasing Salaries of Certain County Offices in Aroostook County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 89, § 98, amended. That part of section 98 of chapter 89 of the revised statutes which relates to the salary of the clerk of courts of Aroostook county is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Aroostook, \$4,500 **\$6,000**,'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 89, § 215, amended. That part of section 215 of chapter 89 of the revised statutes which relates to the salary of the register of deeds of Aroostook county is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Aroostook, northern registry, \$2,700 **\$2,900**; southern registry \$3,200 **\$3,500**,'

Sec. 3. R. S., c. 153, § 22, amended. That part of section 22 of chapter 153 of the revised statutes which relates to the salary of the registry of probate of Aroostook county is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Aroostook, \$2,750 **\$4,350**,'
