COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 354, L.D. 963, Bill, "An Act Relating to Fees of Town Clerks in Recording Copies of Instruments."

Amend said Bill by indicating the striking out of the figure "25¢" in the 8th line thereof by drawing a line through said figure and inserting immediately after said stricken out figure, the underlined figure '50¢'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the last 4 lines thereof and inserting in place thereof the following:
'excess of 500 words; provided, however, if the ~~instrument-to-be recorded-does-not-exceed-in-length-250-words,-the-fee-for-recording-the-same-shall-be-50¢~~ clerk is furnished a copy of the instrument, such copy to be suitable for filing in the town records, the fee therefor shall be \$1.'
